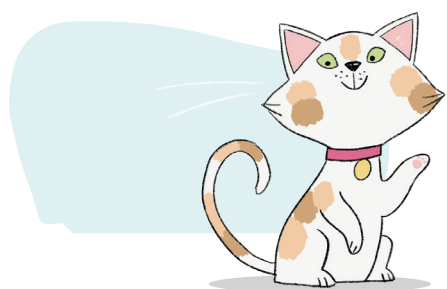


# LIBRO'S FRIENDS

## ACTIVITY SHEET

Welcome to your library! There are lots of books here for you and your family to enjoy.

HERE ARE SOME GREAT ACTIVITIES TO DO WITH YOUR YOUNG CHILD:



### POINT AND NAME



Picture books are great for this game. Point at a picture then say out loud what it is. Can your child copy what you said?

### TREASURE HUNT



Make up your own treasure hunt in the library. For example, how many books can your child find that are blue? How many books have animals on the front?

### MAKE CHOICES



Letting children choose their own books is a great way to build a lifelong love of reading. When your child picks up a book, ask them to tell you about why they chose it.

### LET'S PRETEND



Children love being read to. When you're reading to your child, do funny voices for the characters. Your child might like to join in with this one.

### TEDDY ADVENTURES

Does your child have a favourite teddy? If so, bring it along to the library and show it around!



### CONNECTIONS

Can your child find any books that are similar? For example, do any books have the same word in the title? Does a book remind them of something, like their home or a friend?



### TAKE BOOKS HOME



Choosing library books to take home is a special experience for your child. Remember, it's free to take out library books. When you return them, you can take out some more.
